In the background is my handwriting telling my story dealing with CF. From left to right, there is DNA that was painted and sewn onto the paper. The DNA morphs into lungs that were painted as well. The lungs then turn into the stems of roses. The stems were painted, and the roses themselves were printed, cut, and glued onto the page. The roses form the portrait of someone who is blowing out a breath of air because Cystic Fibrosis is a lung disease.
